Helping your child

- Read stories at bedtime.
- Encourage the use of safety scissors at home—cutting in straight lines and around objects rather than snipping.
- Click on a stationary object with a computer mouse.
- Observe signs of spring when you are in the garden or on a walk
- Use positional language—in, on, behind, below, in front, beside.
- Encourage mark making and drawing.
- Encourage the use of memory- pairs games, remembering 1-6 objects after they have been covered up.



Illness

Please keep us informed if your child is absent or unable to come to school due to illness. The easiest way to let us know is to send a Seesaw message or phone the school office.



There has been a lot of illness in the Nursery recently. We are encouraging the children to regularly wash their hands to try and prevent the spread of germs.

If your child has been vomiting and/or has had diarrhoea, they can return to Nursery once they have been clear of these for 48 hours.

Conjunctivitis— This is highly contagious. An anti-biotic eye drop is needed from the GP. Once they are using the anti-biotic drops, children can return to Nursery.
