Getting ready for Year 1.

Helping your child

- Talk about and look for shapes in the environment.
- Read stories at bedtime.
- Encourage the use of safety scissors at home—cutting in straight lines and around objects rather than snipping.
- Click and drag on a stationary object with a computer mouse.
- Click on a moving object with a computer mouse. Try 'crickweb early Years' games.
- Encourage mark making and drawing.
- Talk positively about Year 1, 'your teacher will be so proud of you because....'
- Encourage recognition of numbers and letters.
- Jump in muddy puddles.
- Roll down a hill.
